So, at 2:00 on one Thursday morning, my phone made a mysterious and ominous "ding." I laid there in bed for a few moments trying to convince myself that it would hold until morning, but curiosity got the best of me. I picked up my phone to see what the ding was all about. It was my mother's bank (just FYI, there are no local branches here). I'm the custodian of that account and have it set up so that if there are withdraws greater than a certain number or if the balance drops below a certain point, I get dinged. The ding was to inform me that a very large sum of money was withdrawn from her account that I did not authorize and I was pretty sure she didn't either. So, I got up and did a little investigating. What had happened is that two checks went through the

reader at the same time, someone else's behind my check, but both amounts came out of mom's account. So I decided to call customer service and get this straightened out.

I called and worked my way through a labyrinth of phone tree and when I finally was connected to the department I needed, I received this message: "Please hold for the next available customer service representative. Due to an unusually high volume of calls at this time, this may take a while. Please be patient." At 2:25am on a Thursday morning, there is an unusually high volume of calls? Thirty-five minutes later, I was talking with a live person who explained that what had happened simply could not have happened. I asked him to look at the picture of the check which would prove him wrong. He asked if I wanted to open an investigation into this. I asked him again to look at the picture of the check and that would be all the investigation that would be needed. They cashed the wrong check out of mom's account. It's as plain as can be. He again asked if I wanted to open an investigation. I asked to speak to his supervisor. I sat on the phone for another 45 minutes waiting for a supervisor.

Now, I'm not writing all of this to complain. I want to contrast this to how God responds to us. As I am writing this I must confess I wanted to type out this sentence: "I want to compare their customer service to God's customer service." That would have been a cute word play, but holistically inaccurate. God doesn't do customer service. He doesn't have customers. He is either Lord or not. We are His creation. We are His workmanship. He owes us nothing and He certainly isn't dependent upon our "business." Yet, how does God respond to our calls for help in our times of need?

"Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you." Jeremiah 29:12

"Then he will pray to God and God will accept him that he may see God's face with joy and God may restore his righteousness to the man." **Job 33:26**

"The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in Truth." Psalm 91:15

"If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you." **John 15:7**

"This is the confidence which we have before Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us." *I John 5:14*

"For do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in our time of need."

Hebrews 4:15-16

And here's one that makes me shutter in awe:

"In the same way, the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us through wordless groans." **Romans 8:26**

God knows what I need before I even pick up the proverbial prayer phone and ask for it! He's praying for me—little old me, Mr. 1 out of 7.9 billion. God is praying for me! No supervisors to talk to for no one is above Him. No investigations needed for God knows all. No need for an attorney for God is the final answer and no one is treated unfairly.

Now, I'm not mad at the bank. This is what human beings do. We make mistakes. We make assumptions. And sometimes we just make things plain difficult for others. All have fallen short of God's glory. To have higher expectations would be unrealistic. What this did do for me is give me a much greater understanding of what I often take for granted.

With the bank, I can take my business elsewhere. Without Jesus, there is no other way. The bank in this case made a big mistake and I have no blame in it. With Christ, I'm the one who blew it beyond my own ability to repair. Yet, even when God owns the monopoly to my access to Heaven. Even when I have messed up so badly that I have no right or hope to fix even myself, much more my relationship with God—even under all of those circumstances, God is closer than my next breath. God knows my needs before I do. When I cry out in need, there is no hold time due to unusually high call activity. Even if every single one of the 9.7 billion on the planet all bowed and prayed at the same time, we all would have God's undivided attention—and His love—and His smile—and His provision given with His wisdom according to His riches in glory—and ultimately His peace.

As King David wrote in Psalm 66:17-20—

I cried to Him with my mouth; and high praise was on my tongue. If I had cherished iniquity in my heart, the Lord would not have listened. But truly God has listened; He has attended to the voice of my prayer. Blessed be God, because He has not rejected my prayer or removed His steadfast love from me!




