Joy. Biblical joy. Its that warm and wonderful feeling to be in the presence and under the protection of God-No matter what the circumstances. Nehemiah declared that the joy of the Lord was his strength. That statement has always fascinated me, especially in context.

Nehemiah was commissioned by God to rebuild the wall of Jerusalem. So he left a very high up position to rough it in the ruins of the once great city of David. When the building project got under way, the grumblers and complainers came out of the woodwork. And not just from his work team. There was growing opposition from others in the area who weren't impressed with the Jews' plans to move back into the area. They smeared his name, threatened his workers, and were just all around difficult. In those circumstances, Nehemiah declared, "The joy of the Lord is our strength."

Again, what an interesting statement. I can think of a lot of other statements I would have used.

All of these statements are just as biblical as what Nehemiah said. So why did he say that? I'm pretty sure what my soul is hearing as an answer here isn't the full answer. It's still profound-at least to me.

Here is what I have come to see so far. Joy-our joy- is extremely important to God. So much so that it is a real source of strength even in circumstances that we normally wouldn't associate with joy. Its a source of strength deeper than duty. It can cause us to reach further than the promise of reward. Joy of the Lord IS our strength, according to Nehemiah.

As I have meditated on this truth, I've begun to ask a question... a lot. "Where is the Joy of the Lord in this?" I'm not just asking this with "spiritual" or" pastoral" things. What I watch on TV or one of my devices. Where's the joy of the Lord in this? Diet and/or exercise routines? Where is the joy of the Lord in this? In paying the bills. In car repairs. In medical issues. In family matters. In conflict. In celebrations. In times of struggle. In times of plenty. In times of misunderstanding. In times of hurt feelings. In times of revelation or reconciliation. In times of challenge. Where is the joy of the Lord for it is the strength I need in that moment?

<sup>&</sup>quot;God's might will ultimately smite."

<sup>&</sup>quot;God will take these troubles and turn them into triumphs."

Now the joy of the Lord isn't the same as happiness. Happiness is dependent upon what is happening. It's circumstantial and about as strong as a good pie crust.

Joy says, "God's got me and He knows what is best. I cannot wait to see what He's going to do here."

Joy says, "God loves me so much."

Joy says, "I can feel God's smile."

Joy says, "I am blessed even if I can't see it right now."

Joy says, "If all things work out for the good for those who love

God and called according to His purpose, then I can't lose!"

It's that warm and wonderful feeling that comes from knowing that the all-knowing, ever-present, all-powerful God has you in the palm of His hand and He delights in you there.

So where's the joy of the Lord in your life? And just as important, where is it not?




